Agricultural Society annual operating grants

We are anticipating that all annual operating grants will be out either by the time you read this or very soon.

Agricultural Society Infrastructure and Revitalization Program (ASIRP)

The 2024/25 round of ASIRP funding will be open either by the time you read this or very soon.

All agricultural societies will be notified when the program application intake opens.

This is a \$2.5 million/year capital grant program to support major repairs at existing agricultural facilities. The program is intended to help address issues related to aging agricultural society infrastructure to promote one or more of the following outcomes:

- Extend the useful life of a facility or infrastructure
- Address health or safety issues
- Improve functionality or service delivery
- Reduce operating costs

Alberta releases drought response plan

Alberta's new 2024 Drought Response Plan will help guide the province through any and all drought conditions. This is a plan covering everything from conservation plans and watersharing agreements to declaring an emergency and prioritizing water for human health and safety. It will help make sure that Albertans, communities, farmers, ranchers and businesses get the support they need, whatever the weather.

AGRICULTURE AND IRRIGATION UPDATE

Century Farm and Ranch Award

The Century Farm and Ranch Award was established in 1993 to honor families who have continuously owned and actively operated the same land for 100 years or more. These families receive an honorary bronze plaque to mark this significant milestone.

In 2018, the program introduced a 125-year farm recognition component to acknowledge the oldest farms and ranches dating back to 1884. Recipients of this honor receive a certificate presented in a formal folder and signed by the Premier and Minister of Agriculture and Irrigation (AGI).

To date, more than 2,000 families have received the Century Farm and Ranch Award, and over 60 families have received the 125-year farm recognition.

In 2020, AGI launched a Century Farm and Ranch digital interactive dashboard, allowing users to search for award recipients by municipality, family name, establishment year, and more.

The application process has been streamlined, with the program area conducting all necessary research to verify establishment and continuous ownership documents.
